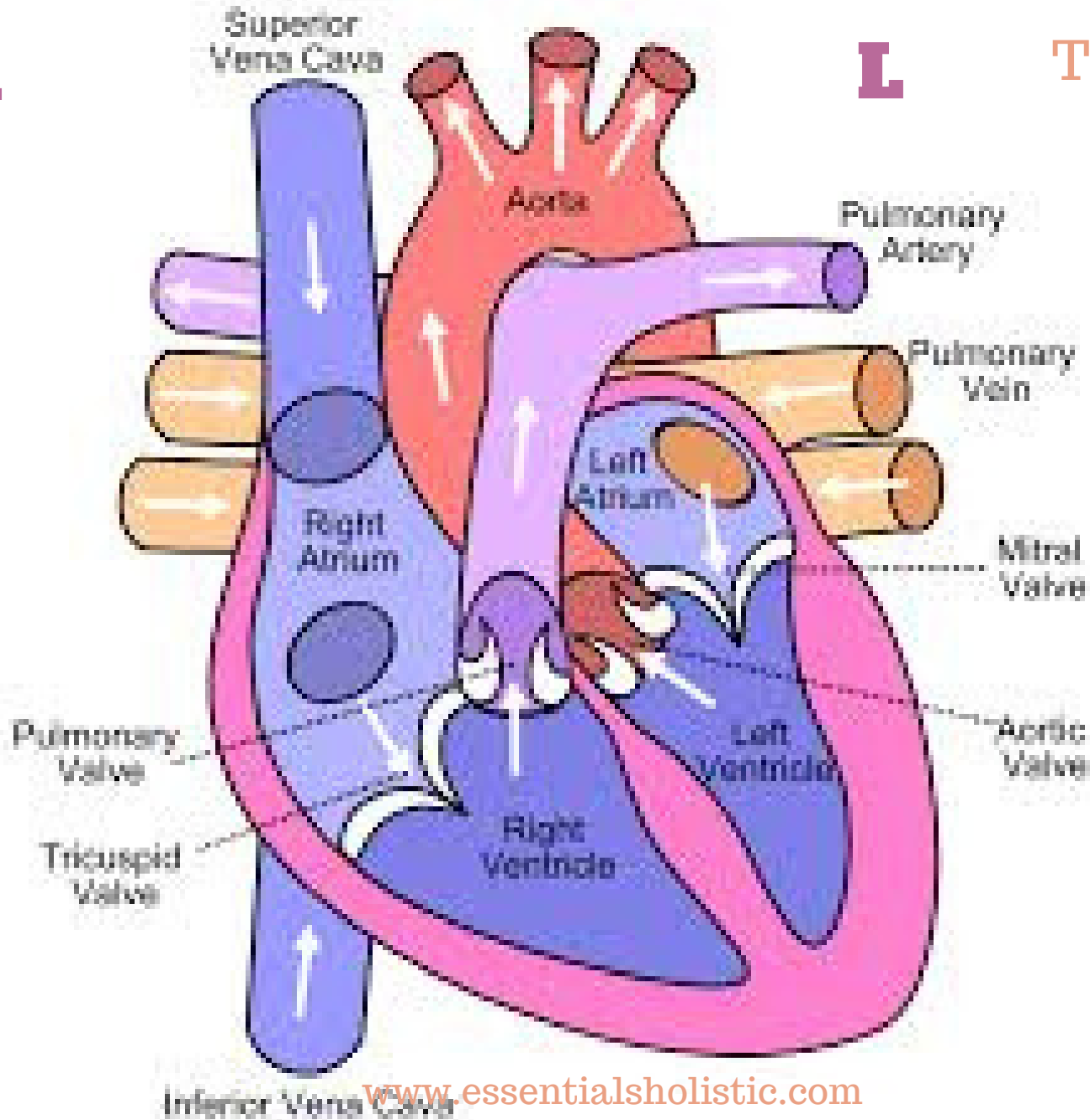

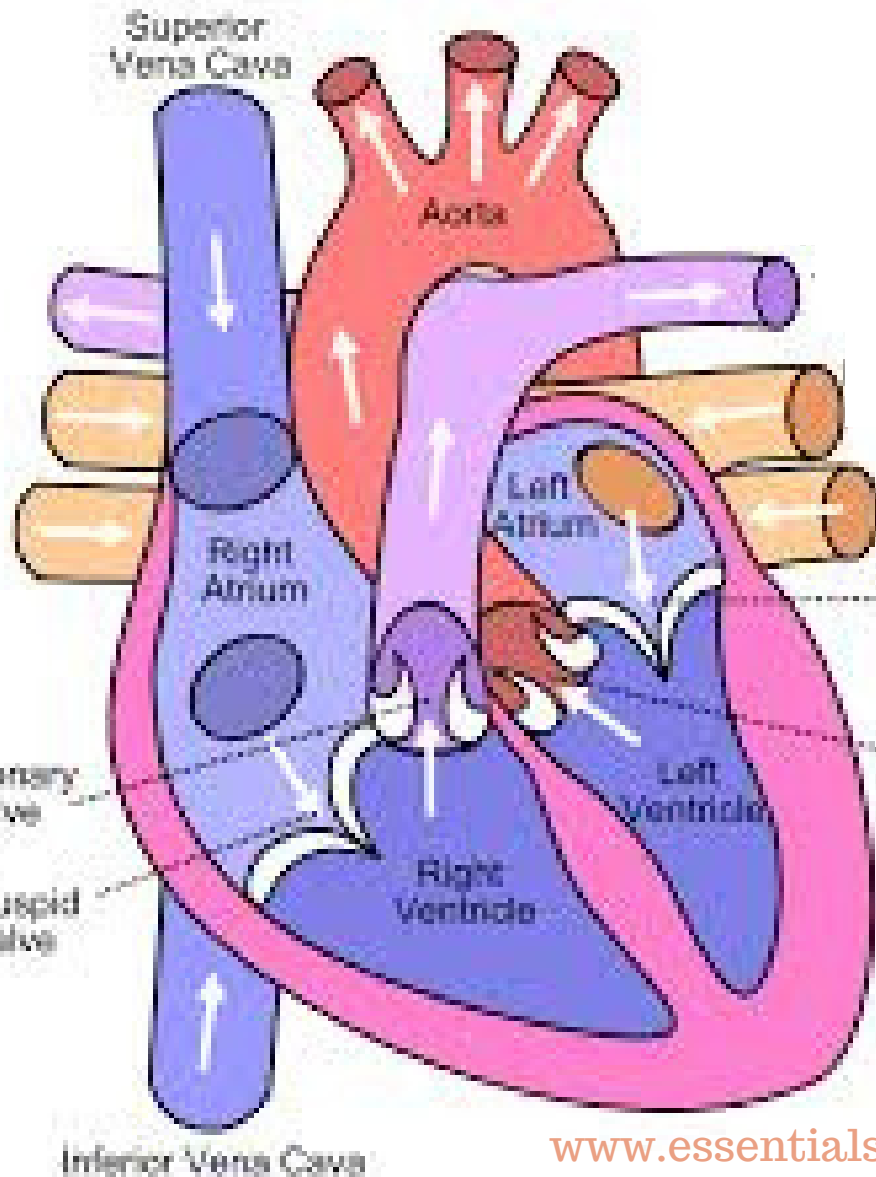

(singular atrium)

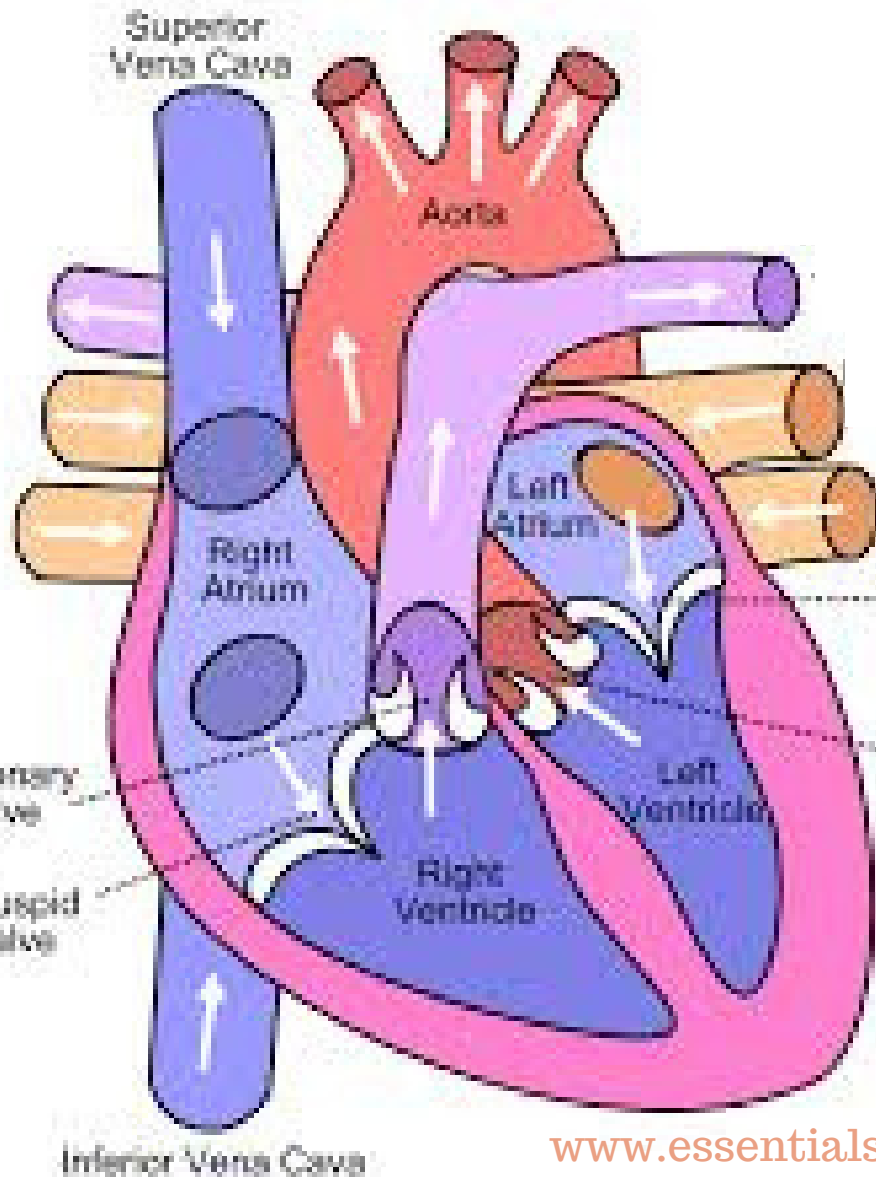
Bottom 2 chambers:-

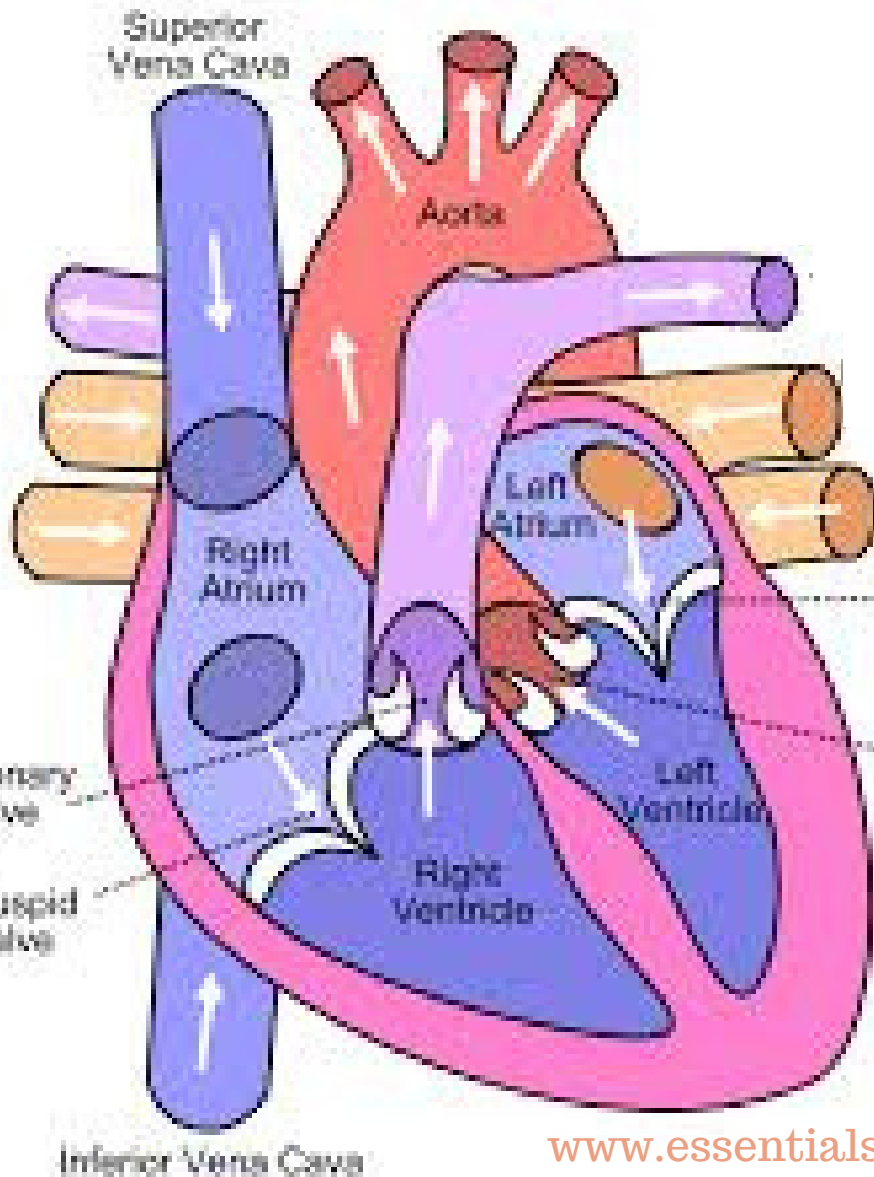


What makes the sound of a heartbeat?

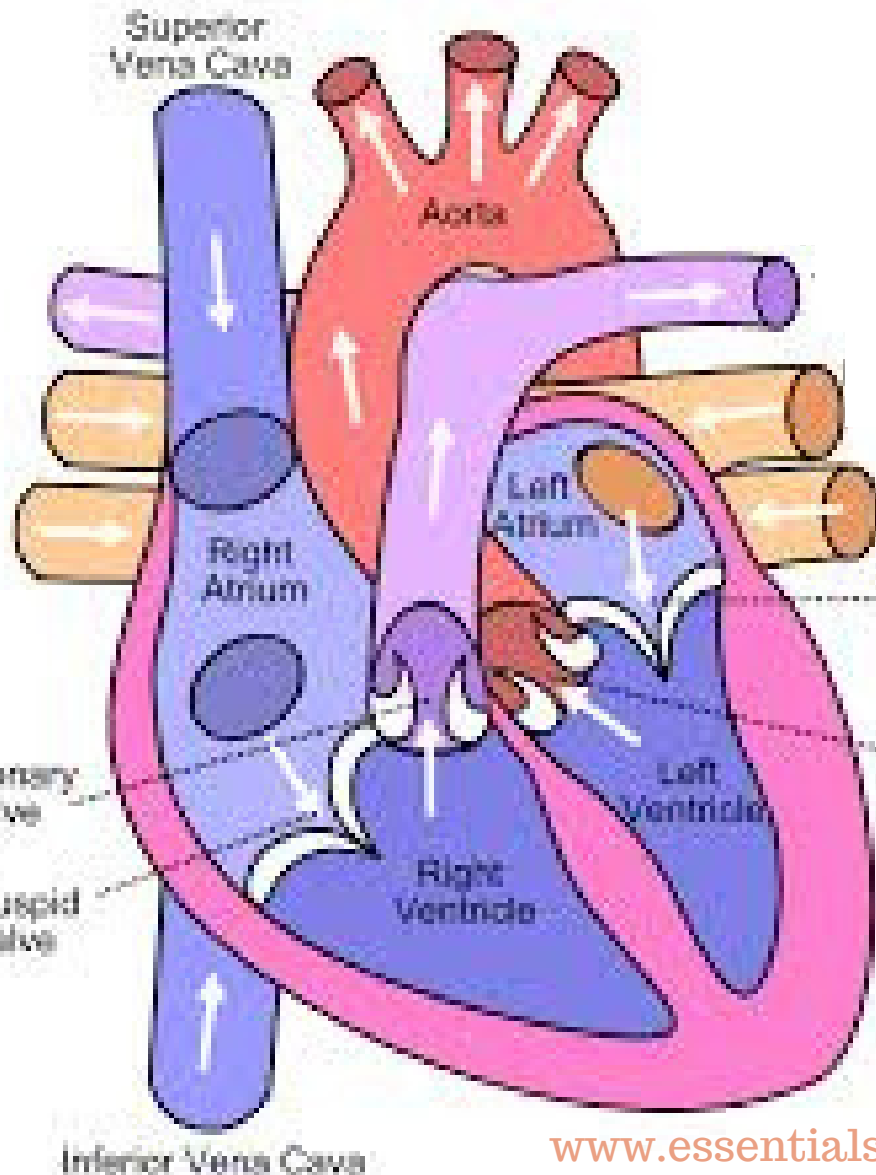
The Heart

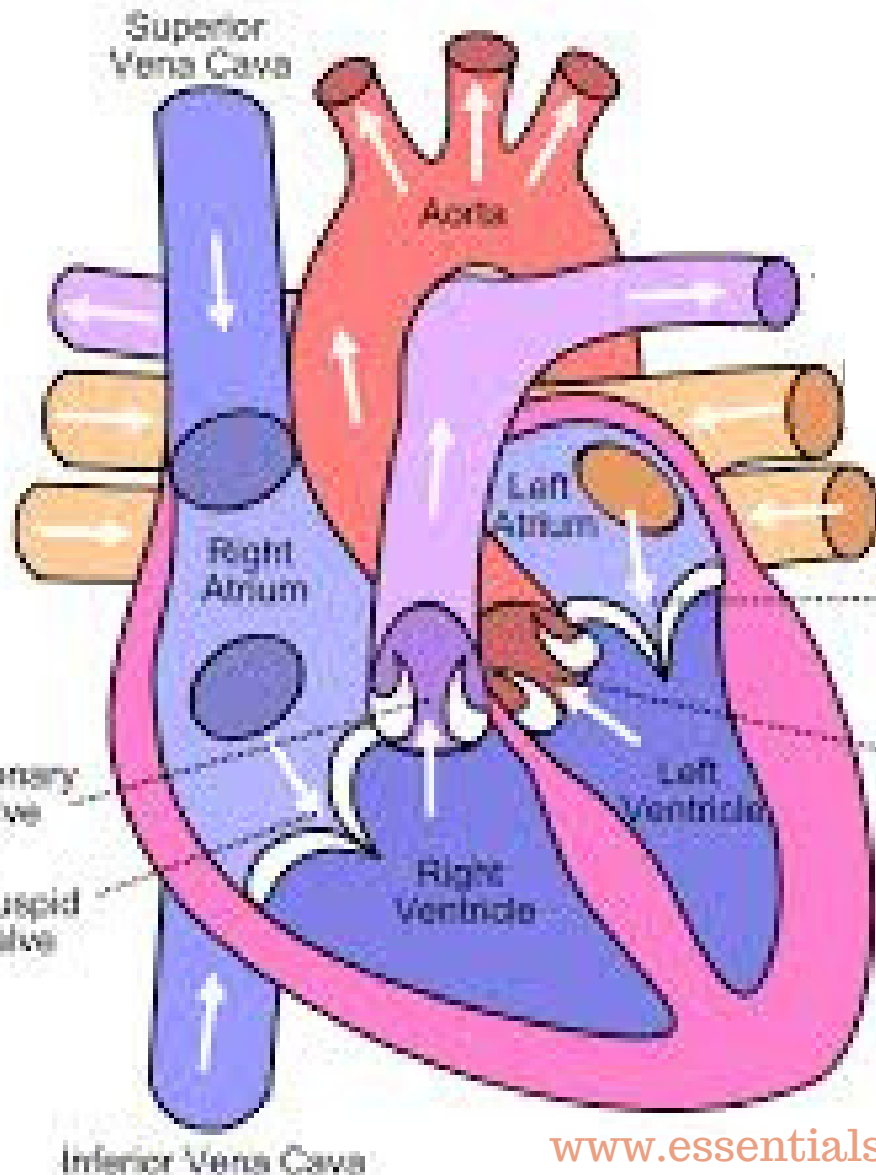
The Heart

Pericardium outer layer (perimeter)

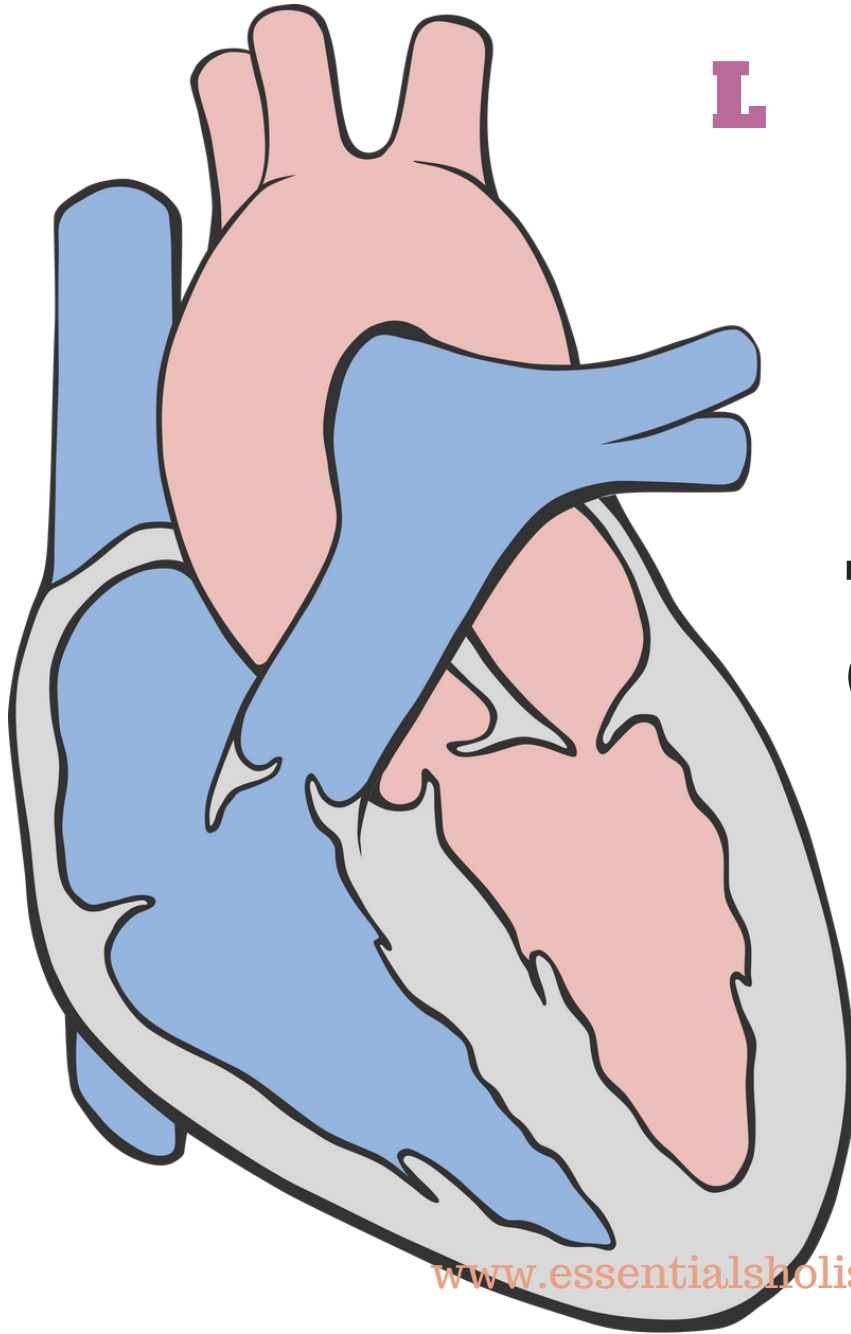
Myocardium in the middle.
